- Appointing a Regional Minister responsible for promoting racial justice and improving our awareness of London as a multi-cultural city—May 2003. ***Achieved with the appointment of Kumar Rajagopalan.***
- Appointing a Regional Minister responsible for mission resourcing—May 2003. ***Achieved with the appointment of David Shosanya.***
- Developing an integrated training programme which draws on a wide range of sources and addresses the needs of the churches, including training focused on mission, racial justice and other diversity issues—June 2004. ***Underway and guided by the Regional Ministry Team.***
- Increasing London's giving to Home Mission aiming to achieve the target of £470,000—Dec 2003. ***Achieved in all but £57.***
- Establishing a smaller churches network—Dec 2003. ***Achieved through the Small Church Connection.***
- Reviewing children's work across London—June 2004—and developing an action programme to support children's work by the churches—Dec 2004. ***Underway by Working with Children Task Group.***
- Continuing to support the development of youth work across London with the LBA youth Co-ordinator—ongoing. ***Currently underway.***
- Developing a group of mediators able to work within churches—Dec 2004. ***Underway and guided by Pat Took.***
