

LONDON BAPTIST ASSOCIATION

A SUMMARY OF THE ELECTION PROCESS

Nominations:

1. Each District is invited to nominate up to four candidates.
2. No more than two of these candidates should be ministers. A District is able to nominate a candidate from another District.
3. The Districts are able to determine for themselves the most appropriate means of arriving at their nominations.
4. Churches are invited to submit names to their District.
5. All nominations should be received by the LBA Office no later than **15 October 2001**.
6. Those who are nominated will be asked to submit a profile of themselves on a pro forma, together with a photograph.

The Election

7. At the beginning of November profiles of the (up to) forty nominees will be circulated to each of the member churches of the new Association.
8. Each church will be entitled to vote for 12 members (not more than six of whom should be ministers).
9. Votes should be submitted to the Association Secretary by 17 December 2001.

We would like to see a Board which:

- t** sets mission at the heart of the life of the Association
- t** reflects the ethnic and cultural diversity of London's Baptists
- t** brings together people with complementary expertise and insights
- t** is representative of the wide spread of church life in London - suburb/inner-city; large /small; charismatic/traditional etc...
- t** is balanced between male and female and has younger as well as older members
- t** has creative and visionary people who will think adventurously about our life together in Association
- t** exhibits spiritual wisdom and insight
